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enlivened with a thoughtful palette of pearl white, cinnabar red and jade green. Nature infused wall coverings, painted with flocks of birds, blossoming canopies and dancing butterflies, draw the calm of the natural world indoors, fashioning serene retreats of unhurried sophistication. Every room carries the imprint of a distinct historical epoch, adorned with period authentic maps of Macau that trace the city's metamorphosis back to the 19th century. Captivating custom crafted sports car shaped beds await young racing enthusiasts, while murals chart the twists and turns of the iconic street circuit, letting children live out the thrill of tearing along Macau's fabled racetrack. Built around the heroic discovery of the Time Voyage Ship, the Nautical Themed Suite brims with playful interactive touches: a ship's helm, a brass-styled compass, and fluid, dynamic wave projections. Its bathroom transforms into an enchanted underwater domain, where hidden sea creatures emerge layer upon layer, igniting children's sense of wonder, exploration and boundless imagination.
